During February 20th and 22nd, the MaDiTraCe project consortium meeting took place in Leoben, organized by Montanuniversitaet Leoben. This project aims to expand and integrate technological solutions for the traceability and certification of raw material supply chains in a responsible and sustainable manner, through a Digital Product Passport (DPP), aligned with the EU battery passport. Montanuniversitaet is involved in the work on WP1 and WP2, where WP1 develops a knowledge base to support other work packages, offering an overview of the current situation of due diligence in the supply chain of raw materials. On the other hand, WP2 focuses on developing technologies for the identification of materials and their traceability in specific supply chains, such as magnets and batteries, covering key raw materials like Li, natural graphite, Co, and REEs, with a special focus on Nd.
